





A. Product Description:

The Switch-It TouchDrive 2 (TD2) utilizes proven cellphone touchscreen technology for ultra-sensitive and precise proportional driving capabilities. The user simply makes contact with the glass surface of the device for activation, there is no force required. Maintaining contact with the screen will allow for full driving capabilities as programmed in the power wheelchair including turning, veering/steering, and spinning.

B. Technical Information:


- Alternative Control Type: Proportional
- Activation Type: Capacitive Touchscreen
- Activating Force: No force required, only contact with the touchscreen
- Feedback: Power wheelchair movement
- Connector Type: D-Sub 9 connection to wheelchair display

C. Compatibility

- Penny & Giles R-Net Electronics: Omni is required.
- Curtis Electronics Enable 50: Enhanced Display is required.
- Dynamic Controls DX2: Switch It DX Dongle (DXD) is required.
- Invacare Electronics: Invacare MK6 Sip N' Puff Module (SNPMK6) is required. MicroPilot for Invacare (MP-I) version must be requested at time of order.

D. Key Features

- The TD2 has a built-in mode switch on the bottom part of the screen (Switch-It logo), which can be disabled if not desired, Figure 3. This feature can be enabled/disabled by pressing the green recessed button located on the underside of the device, Figure 4.
- If the built-in mode switch is not desired, there is a 1/8" monojack port for external mechanical mode switches, which eliminates the need to have a switch and extension cable plugged into the Omni or Enhanced Display, Figure 3.
- The TD2 can be configured to work in a simple touch (Absolute Mode) or drag (Relative Mode) manner, depending on the client's usage needs & desires. The TD2 will come from Switch-It in Absolute Mode. To change this mode, press the blue recessed button located on the underside of the device, Figure 4.
 - o Absolute Mode Similar to a standard joystick, the center of the touchscreen is neutral.
 - Making contact anywhere away from center/neutral will drive the power wheelchair in that direction.









Key Features (continued)

- The farther away from the center/neutral contact is made will cause the power wheelchair to drive faster.
- The LED located on the underside of the device blinking RED indicates the device is in Absolute Mode and the power wheelchair is driving, Figure 5.
- o Relative Mode This mode allows for center/neutral to be defined by the first touch.
 - First contact with the touchscreen establishes neutral but does not cause the power wheelchair to move.
 - Once contact is established, the user should maintain contact and drag their finger, etc. in the direction they wish to go. The further away from the new center/neutral the user drags, the faster their power wheelchair will go.
 - The LED located on the underside of the device blinking BLUE indicates the device is in Relative Mode and the power wheelchair is driving, Figure 5.
- Throw adjustments can be adjusted through the power wheelchair electronics; device needs to be in Absolute Mode.
